## Construction Alert



Work on a three part project to correct drainage conditions and replace hazardous sidewalks is scheduled for the next three to four weeks. The project involves the south courtyard, north courtyard and around University House. During construction, access to the south courtyard will be disrupted. Alternate access to the fellowship hall and office areas will be necessary. A large drainage retention pit will be installed in the front lawn and will also temporarily disrupt access to the parking lot. The North courtyard involves a concrete pad for new storage shed and sidewalk replacement. Work at University house includes regradeing the lawn area around three sides of the house, installation of water barrier fabric around the exterior foundation walls and replacing sidewalks. It is expected that these projects will eliminate flooding and provide safer conditions around the building. Efforts will be made to minimize the inconvenience of this project.
